

INFORMATION FOR CANCER COUNCIL WA 'THE LONGEST DAY' ON ROTTNEST ISLAND 2024

Last year, the Rottnest Island Golf Club played host to the only 'offshore' Longest Day charity golf event in Australia. This was the inaugural Longest Day event held on Rotto. The support from the Rottnest Island community, the Rottnest Island Golf Club, SeaLink, and the Western Australian golfing community and the fundraising efforts from the participants, made for an incredible event.

The Longest Day is the ultimate golf challenge designed to test the participants skill, strength and stamina. This event has been running nationally for 10 years and has raised over \$2.1M this financial year. All proceeds raised in Western Australia go directly to Cancer Council WA to assist research, prevention and support to Western Australian's affected by cancer.

With a fundraising total of \$38,568, the RIGC was the highest fundraising club in metro WA and 6th nationally. The team, Jake Strength, was the 4th highest fundraising team out of 1151 teams Australia wide. 14 participants completed 72 holes of golf and 2 completed 54 on the iconic course. The traditional 'Longest Day' format was accompanied with a 27-hole event on the following day, with 36 participants.

The commitment and generosity shown by so many people made this event extra special. Over \$18,500 was donated as in-kind sponsorship. The appreciation from all players were truly felt throughout both days. Please continue to support the following businesses that supported this event last year:

Accommodation

All participants have their personal reasons for participating in such an event. The stories shared, camaraderie experienced, and small amounts of healing achieved, was incredibly powerful last year. We're inspired to make the 2024 event even more meaningful to a larger group.

Presentations / Celebrations

At the conclusion of each day, there will be a celebration of the achievements of the day. Details for each event will be released closer to the date. The main presentations will commence at the end of the Ambrose Event on Sunday 17th November at approximately 3.30pm.

Sponsors

Fundraising / Event Fees

Every participant playing on Friday 15th and Saturday 16th November (The Longest Day) will be required to meet a minimum fundraising requirement set on the Cancer Council website. This includes 4 rounds of golf, food and drink throughout the day, complimentary return travel to Rottnest with SeaLink (including Rottnest Island Authority landing fee), free entry into the Ambrose Tournament (another round of golf and food on the day) and a chance to win some incredible prizes. All donations are tax deductible, and every dollar goes directly to Cancer Council WA.

Note: The anticipated minimum donation is currently set at \$500, however, this may change. Last year, the average amount raised per participant was over \$1,000.

Players only participating in the Ambrose competition on Sunday, will be required to pay the following fees prior to the day. All proceeds from this event go towards The Longest Day fundraising.

9 holes Ambrose Competition (social golfers and children) - \$50 per player.

- 18 holes Ambrose Competition (Golflink number required) \$120 per player.
 - Entry into this competition green fees, prizes (high level for 18-hole event), food at presentations, discounted return ferry travel with SeaLink.
 - NOTE: All spectators and support staff travelling over for The Longest Day and Ambrose Event will be provided with a discounted fare with SeaLink. The code will be provided during registration.
