

Members Code of Conduct

All members of the Rottnest Island Golf Club (Inc) agree to abide by the following guidelines to protect and enhance the golfing experience at the Rottnest Island Golf Club.

MEMBERS PLEDGE TO:

- Become familiar with and comply with the relevant regulations of Golf WA.
- Become familiar with and comply with the rules of the Constitution and the By Laws of the Rottnest Island Golf Club.
- Become familiar with and comply with the conditions of your membership category.
- Promote the highest levels of sportsmanship and fair play and conduct yourself in a manner that is both honorable and in keeping with the spirit of fair play and sportsmanship.
- Treat all other members and their guests, visitors to the Club, Staff and Committee, fairly, equally and with respect.
- At all times, play by the rules of the Club and the laws of the game of golf.
- Observe the highest standard of behavior on the course, in the clubhouse and it's surrounds, and when representing the club at other venues.
- Always act in the best interest of Rottnest Island Golf Club.
- Not demean, nor offend other club members and their guests, visitors, staff and committee based on race, colour, religion or physical characteristics.
- Comply with the Liquor Licensing Laws relating to the responsible service of alcohol as applied to the Club under its license conditions.
- Not to take open alcoholic beverages outside the Club's Licensed area.
- Not to consume alcoholic beverages, either on the course or in the Clubhouse and the Club's licensed area, that have not been purchased from the Rottnest Island Golf Clubhouse.



ON THE COURSE, MEMBERS WILL:

- Arrive at the course at least fifteen minutes prior to your tee off time.
- Inform another player if you believe they are about to breach a rule of golf or a bylaw of the
- If you observe another player/member deliberately breaching a rule, you MAY bring it to the attention of the player concerned, but you MUST report it to the Captain of the Club or committee member and provide a clear written statement in relation to the matter.
- When playing a ball off a fairway other than the one that you are playing, you MUST wait until the players playing that fairway have played their ball. You must signal that you wish to come on their fairway to play your ball and once played, you must remove yourself from their fairway as quickly as possible.
- Follow all recommendations and directions regarding pace of play. The lowest handicapper in any group is responsible for ensuring the pace of play is maintained in their group.

Breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with in accordance with the Club's Complaints and Disputes Policy and may result in suspension or cancellation of membership.
